

Sanctuary Weddings

Many prefer a wedding in our main sanctuary. With ten full-length pews and seating for approximately 300, it features a high, vaulted wood grain ceiling and a more contemporary feel. As a symbol of our Christian faith, a bronze cross is the focus at the end of the main aisle.



The wooden altar can be incorporated or moved out of the way, as needed. The multimedia screen can be raised or lowered depending on the need for each service and lighting and window blinds can be adjusted for appropriate mood lighting.

On the right is the view from up front as the bride enters through the double doors in the Narthex and makes her way down the aisle. The upper Tech Loft is where sound and video are controlled and can function as a novel vantage point for photographers and videographers.



Lower left is another view toward the back and at left is a look at the casual seats in the Narthex in the back of the church overlooking the courtyard. Through the windows on the right behind the plants you can make out **Higher Grounds**, the coffee house often used by bridesmaids to make their final preparations.
